AN INTENSIVE MULTI-DAY DESIGN PROCESS THAT INVOLVES YOU
AND RESULTS IN A MASTER PLAN FOR YOUR LAND THAT YOU CAN IMPLEMENT OVER TIME

Want to spend more time in your yard but it's just not working for you right now?
Have a tired city lot or an acre in the woods and have no idea where to begin?
Talked to design/build outfits and they want you to do everything at once?
Hoping you might come up with some designs you can do yourself?
Interested in working with a landscape architect but worried they might be too expensive?

Treeline's Planning for Outdoor Living process helps you create a big vision for your land, then be flexible with how and when you see it through.

How it works:

Day 1: Treeline has dinner with you, in your home, to talk about your wants, needs, desires, likes, dislikes, and anything else you feel like discussing. Dinner is on you – it's the best way for Treeline to see how you use space.

Day 2: Treeline returns the very next day for design work. First I'll create a generalized measured drawing of your land (something you might want for talking with contractors and buying building materials later). Then I'll sketch and plan, and put stakes in the ground, and come up with some preliminary ideas. When you come home, we'll take a look at what Treeline came up with. We'll share your ideas and tweak the designs, spending a nice evening getting to a concept for your entire yard.

Office Time: Treeline will draw up the master plan, to scale, within a week or two.

Day 3: Treeline will come back for a short visit to present (and leave with you) the master plan and talk with you about next steps. Are there things you can do yourself? What should you do first? We can address these and other questions. Then we're finished. In a week or so, you have, in your soon-to-be-calloused-from-hard-yard-work hands, a master plan for your land that you helped create. Ta da!

Advantages of this process:

- Adam Arvidson, ASLA, Treeline's founder, is a registered landscape architect. This quick-hitter process allows you to get a professional design at a reasonable price (the phrase "landscape architect designed grounds" does have an impact on property value...).
- We're not selling shrubs or stone or retaining wall block, so we'll design what's best for you, not what's best for our inventory.
- YOU ARE INVOLVED. Remember that. You need to live with this, so you should be a designer, too. By meeting with you on three occasions, we let you help us.
- Residential design is NOT about where to put planting beds. It is about how you will use your outdoor spaces. We take the approach that once we have a good master plan that outlines how you will move through and use your yard (Treeline is a stickler for circulation), you can alter the materials based on budget, know-how, and tastes at the time.
- One fee, no hidden charges. You know exactly what you're getting into.
